Below is a list of Frequently Asked Questions about One Place, which will be held in Charleston, South Carolina from Wednesday, April 25 to Friday, April 27 at the <u>Charleston Place Hotel</u>.

EVENT DETAILS

Q: When does registration begin and end?

A: Registration is now open through Wednesday, April 18. The registration fee is \$349. Register now!

Q: How do I pay for my registration?

A: The Charleston International Airport. The airport code is CHS.
